What is a Learning Community?

Limitless Learning Communities are part of our vision to strengthen, challenge, envision and encourage youth leaders within the Elim Movement.

We've all experienced seminars when an expert presents some stunning teaching which we all feverishly make notes of, often get inspired by, but then go away scratching our heads trying to work out how we can apply what they've shared or experienced fellowship groups where we sit in a circle and share with one another and then pray. A learning Community is not a seminar or a fellowship group.

Learning Communities are designed to help youth leaders consider the effectiveness of their current practises, inspire them to enlarge their vision and create an environment for practical next step responses which are contextualised to their present environment.

The Key Distinctives of a Learning Community

- They help leaders reflect 'where they are' and consider the effectiveness of their current practises.
- They help leaders to dream big and enlarge their vision.
- They create space for pragmatic next step responses contextualised to their present environment.
- They provide accountability to help motivate ideas into actions.
- They provide an opportunity to share journey both locally and nationally.

Limitless Learning Communities

- Learning Communities are birthing all over the country and can be formed when there is between 3-7 churches in a geographical area who are committed to joining.
- They are for Youth Leaders (volunteer or employed) and their teams.
- They meet 3 times a year – usually Winter, Spring and Autumn.
- A DVD is supplied with the topic and structure for each meeting
