Giveaway Packs. Think about what you could put in, information about your church, your mens group and the beginings of faith.

Appoint someone to bring the packs, be the point of contact for giving them out and collecting any information in.





Hoover the room! At one point in the evening get every man at the event to fill in an Information Card. Visitors will go with the herd but given the choice will want to remain anonymous!

Filled cards = potential follow up.
Remember to do something with them...

Men "On Point." Prep some of your key men to introduce themselves to your guests at the end of the evening. Be friendly open and engaging.





Gospel Appeals need to be handled well. At your event make sure you have men trained in what to do when someone accepts Jesus as Saviour.

Appoint someone to co-ordinate this.

Plug Your Next Event. Make sure it is a good one and something that new guys can buy into fully and easily.

Initiate Follow Up. Try and meet those who made a decision to encourage them as they start the adventure of faith.

Establish an Alpha Course or Christianity Explored Course exclusively for men. Have a date set up and details available.





Feedback. Find out what your guys thought about the night. What worked? What would they do differently? What will they do the next time?

Pray. It is how we started, it is how we finish! Give thanks to the Lord for the event, for the guys who invited others, for those who came, those who heard and those who accepted Jesus as Saviour.





Continue it. Keep up the friendship and keep God on the agenda encouraging your friend in their new found faith.

Plan. Think about the welcome, who will talk / share testimony and when that will take place in the night?




