



CHRIS CARTWRIGHT

Chris Cartwright is the General Superintendent of the Elim Pentecostal Church. The son of Elim pastor Des Cartwright, Chris was ordained in 1993 and ministered for over twenty-five years in two city churches. He began his ministry in the late 1980's serving on the pastoral team in Kensington Temple in a variety of ministry roles including Worship Pastor and Director of IBIOL. From 1997-2010, Chris was the Senior Pastor of the City Temple in Cardiff, (now renamed as City Church, Cardiff). In 2010 he became the Regional Leader for Wales and the Southern Region before being appointed as the General Superintendent of Elim in May 2016. Chris is married to Annie and they have three children.

DAVID CAMPBELL

David is Regional Leader of Elim's Metropolitan East and Metropolitan West regions, where he provides covering and leadership to around 130 churches. He lives in St Albans with his wife Mandy. LEON EVANS

Leon is the Lead Pastor of Life Central Church (Halesowen) and as a 'local lad' has a passion for not only the local church but also for the region and beyond. The Church is now 'multi site' meeting in 3 locations with a newly refurbished building and extensive community work impacting hundreds of people every week. Leon founded the youth charity Phase Trust and also has a passion for leadership development locally and overseas. Married to Allison they have 2 sons; love films, good food, live music and Aston Villa (somebody has to!)

SEX, THE GOSPEL AND THE REVOLUTION: HOW CAN WE TELL A BETTER STORY?

The sex revolution, rooted in a powerful cultural narrative of authenticity and freedom, has brought about far-reaching changes in attitudes to sex, marriage and gender. In this challenging context, how can Christians who hold to biblical teaching begin to craft a narrative that wins hearts as well as minds?

GLYNN HARRISON

Glynn Harrison was formerly Professor and Head of Department of Psychiatry, University of Bristol, where he was also a practicing Consultant Psychiatrist. He now speaks widely on issues at the interface between Christian faith and psychology, pastoral ministry and psychiatry. He and his wife Louise are members of Emmanuel Church, a plant from Christ Church, Clifton. His new book 'A Better Story: God, sex and human flourishing' is published by IVP.

KIERA PHYO

Kiera has recently started working for Archbishop Justin Welby in his Reconciliation Ministry; where she is Director of the Reconciling Leaders Network and is developing a global movement of peacemakers. Previously she worked at Tearfund for over a decade, pioneering a lifestyle response to global poverty and leading their engagement with an emerging generation. She regularly broadcasts on BBC Radio 2 as a Pause for Thought contributor. She is a trustee of The Cinnamon Network and Fusion. Kiera lives in London with her young family.

John Kirkby began CAP in 1996 with only £10 and a passion to see the poor set free. Together with CEO Matt Barlow, he has led the charity and seen it grow to transform over 21,500 lives every year. With 25 years of leadership experience including planting and team-leading the Light Church, John was named Sunday Times Best Leader, alongside Matt. His heart is to inspire others to unlock their own potential by looking honestly at the challenges faced in leadership.

BOYD RATNARAJA

Boyd moved to New Zealand from Sri Lanka with his family when he was 16 years old. Boyd has been on staff at Elim Christian Centre for the past sixteen years. In 2009, he and his wife became Lead Pastors of the South campus. Since that time the church has grown to be the second largest in Elim New Zealand. Boyd has served on the National Leadership team of Elim NZ since 2011 and was elected as National Leader in October 2017. He is married to Sharon and they have a son.



DEAR 26 YEAR OLD ME

Ben will chronicle how he grew Hope for Justice from a standing start to the global anti-trafficking organisation it is today as part of God's mission, sharing his leadership lessons for anyone who is developing their own team.

BEN COOLEY

Ben Cooley co-founded Hope for Justice in the UK in 2008 to bring an end to modern slavery and human trafficking. He rapidly grew it into a multi-award winning charity with strong links with governments and police forces, with a mission to bring an end to modern slavery by rescuing victims, restoring lives and reforming society. His team now includes former senior investigators and detectives, a former member of the UK National Police Chiefs Council, lawyers, social workers, and communications and policy experts.









Karunia* is one of many Christians in Aceh, Indonesia, whose churches have been demolished or burnt down by people opposed to their faith in Jesus. But this is not why she is crying.

When she was told that her photo would be shared with Christians around the world who would pray for and support her, she wept with joy, saying: "I thought we were alone and forgotten. No news ever mentions us anymore."
