

IMPORTANCE OF SUNDAY

- Sunday not primarily about discipleship
- Celebration Enjoyment, Inspiration
- Oasis Refreshment, Peace, Strength, Anchor
- Fellowship Encouragement, Supporting, Empowering
- Learning
- Preaching is the most relevant to discipleship
- Prompting to act
- Equipping
- Giving confidence
- Earthed in everyday, examples of practical application



SHARING STORIES - STRONGLY VALUED BY ALL

- Stories told are mainly about celebration
- People being saved, miracles
- Inspiring
- Stories help with discipleship most when they help with ongoing intimacy
- Get to know people better
- Get to know God better, and how he is working
- Examples of God at work in everyday lives
- Strong views that there should be more story sharing



GROUPS

- Life groups, Connect groups, Missional Community groups, Huddles
- Structural best practice
- Encourage everyone to be in a group, including newcomers
- Provide guidance but not rigid prescription
- Allow for flexibility
- Don't make studies too difficult
- A mix of people regarding discipleship



BALLYMENA: LIFE GROUPS ARE NEW

- Prior to life groups, apart from your immediate circle of family and friends, I wouldn't
 have known what's going on in everybody else's life, ... I'm not sure how much of an
 impact that had on a day-to-day, weekly basis.
- [How does your church connect with your everyday lives?] It connects quite a bit for us, more because we went through the last five weeks of small groups. So, prior to that, I would've said, "Maybe not so much." We felt that maybe it didn't connect as much as it does, through life groups. Sharing our experiences together, day-to-day life and the challenges it has.
- [Discipleship] I think it was up to the individual. Whereas now, the way that life groups have been formed ... you find this is how we're going to bring you in a wee bit deeper. Before, it was up the individual.



"Freedom in Christ course has been life changing. I've been a Christian a long, long time, but this last year it's like proper discipleship, learning who I am and my role. I've fretted about things for years and I don't need to. I just need to be the best wife I can be, the best mum I can be, colleague. I don't need to be constantly trying to be somebody else, now I'm just me. I'm more relaxed. I feel I know who I am, where before, I struggled. For the first time I fully understand who I am in Christ and what my purpose is. "



WHERE TIME IS SPENT IN A TYPICAL WEEK






