

ADDITIONAL NEEDS

Overview:

The Additional Needs Team plays a vital role in ensuring that every young person can fully engage with and enjoy the festival experience, regardless of their individual needs. The team provides compassionate, practical support to young people with physical, sensory, cognitive, emotional, or behavioural challenges.

Responsibilities and requirements:

- Supporting Young People with Additional Needs to feel included and be engaged in the main teaching and worship sessions at Limitless Festival, promoting the development of their understanding and personal relationship with Jesus.
- Supporting reasonable adjustments and access requirements for Young People with Additional Needs in the main Youth venue and as required across the wider festival site, under the direction of the team leader.
- Supporting alternative communication, sensory and behavioural needs of Young People within the main Youth venue at Limitless.
- Working as part of a team to oversee the Sensory space within the Youth venue and Quiet space at Limitless festival, providing alternative activities and resources which support engagement and participation within the main teaching and worship sessions.
- Providing Additional Needs support to other venues and teams at Limitless festival on an 'as required' basis under the direction of the team leader.
- All team members are expected to support and take responsibility for the wellbeing and safety of young people and must follow emergency procedures whenever required to manage the overall event. This responsibility applies at all times, including overnight. You may be asked to provide support outside of your assigned shift, including teaching, caring for or supervising children in other teams such as the additional needs team, sports and others.

How to Apply:

If you are interested in applying for this team please follow the QR code. The application deadline is **Wednesday 1st July 2026**.

To be accepted onto this team every member needs to have a completed reference. Your referee needs to be someone who has had leadership authority over you. This preferably needs to be a youth leader, or senior leader but we will also accept a work manager or a school teacher.

Your referee needs to have known you for at least 1 year.

You must need to have a valid Child Workforce DBS check either completed by Limitless or provide one that is on the update service. The deadline to apply for a new DBS is **Monday 6th July 2026**.

You will need to complete the safeguarding training that we will send to you before coming onto site.

You will need to be on site from Wednesday 5th August and can arrive from 9am to set up and **MUST** attend the first all teams meeting at 2pm.
