Overview:

Are you an energetic and creative individual who loves working with kids? Join our Kids Team and be part of the team that makes the festival a fun and memorable experience for our youngest festival-goers. Your responsibilities will include organizing and supervising fun activities and ensuring the safety and happiness of the children throughout the festival.

Responsibilities and requirements:

- Attend pre-festival team meeting
- Join a festival kids team WhatsApp
- Read, acknowledge and understand safeguarding and safety rules surrounding working with children.
- Serve in one of 3 age groups: 0-3, 4-7, 8-11.
- Create a warm and inviting atmosphere for every child.
- Keep Jesus at the centre of all we do.
- To be in amongst the children throughout the programme.
- Follow the direction of room leaders including the kids team lead.
- Be available for set up and pack down around each session and bookending festival.
- There is potential to help with games, hosting, activities, worship.
- Aiding with toileting needs where necessary.
- Clear communication with other members of team.
- Be flexible to fill in gaps as and when it's needed.
- Come expectant, ready and excited for a brilliant time with the children at festival
 - All team members are expected to support and take responsibility for the wellbeing and safety of young people and must follow emergency procedures whenever required to manage the overall event. This responsibility applies at all times, including overnight. You may be asked to provide support outside of your assigned shift, including teaching, caring for or supervising children in other teams such as the additional needs team, sports and others.

How to Apply:

If you are interested in applying for this team please follow the QR code. The application deadline is **Wednesday 1st July 2026**.

To be accepted onto this team every member needs to have a completed reference. Your referee needs to be someone who has had leadership authority over you. This preferably needs to be a youth leader, or senior leader but we will also accept a work manager or a school teacher. Your referee needs to have known you for at least 1 year.

You must need to have a valid Child Workforce DBS check either completed by Limitless or provide one that is on the update service. The deadline to apply for a new DBS is **Monday 6th July 2026**.

You will need to complete the safeguarding training that we will send to you before coming onto site.

You will need to be on site from Wednesday 5th August and can arrive from 9am to set up and **MUST** attend the first all teams meeting at 2pm.
