

# VILLAGE HOSTS

## Overview:

Are you a caring and organized individual who wants to ensure everyone has a comfortable and enjoyable experience? Join our Village Host Team, where you'll play a pivotal role in taking care of our delegates back at their campsite.

## Responsibilities and requirements:

The site has a number of coloured Zones where delegates will be camping. Each Zone is divided into different villages, and you will be overseeing those who are camping in one of those villages. Your job will be to keep the P's:

### PRACTICAL

On Day Zero allocate spaces for groups assigned to your village according to their size.

On Day 1, as delegates arrive, be on your village ready to direct them to those spaces, allocating cook tents around the edges where possible.

### PERSONAL

Be the go-to point for your village for information and/or help.

As groups are setting up, introduce yourself to all the leaders of the groups in your village explaining where you can be found. (It would be good to make your tent distinctive with a sign or flag so people can easily find you).

### PARKING

Ensure that no cars remain on site at the end of Day 1, unless they are blue badge holders.

### PASTORAL

During the week look out for those who may be camping on your village who are on their own or are wandering around on their own, including youth leaders. Check they are okay and listen out for feedback as to how they are feeling.

### POLICING

Endeavour to quieten loud voices after midnight when delegates return to their villages each evening. (Food vendors close at 11pm)

- All team members are expected to support and take responsibility for the wellbeing and safety of young people and must follow emergency procedures whenever required to manage the overall event. This responsibility applies at all times, including overnight. You may be asked to provide support outside of your assigned shift, including teaching, caring for or supervising children in other teams such as the additional needs team, sports and others.

## How to Apply:

If you are interested in applying for this team please follow the QR code. The application deadline is **Wednesday 1<sup>st</sup> July 2026**.

To be accepted onto this team every member needs to have a completed reference. Your referee needs to be someone who has had leadership authority over you. This preferably needs to be a youth leader, or senior leader but we will also accept a work manager or a school teacher.

Your referee needs to have known you for at least 1 year.

You must need to have a valid Child Workforce DBS check either completed by Limitless or provide one that is on the update service. The deadline to apply for a new DBS is **Monday 6<sup>th</sup> July 2026**.

You will need to complete the safeguarding training that we will send to you before coming onto site.

You will need to be on site from Tuesday 4<sup>th</sup> August and can arrive from 3pm to set up and **MUST** attend the first all teams meeting at 7pm.
