

DRIVING

Overview:

Our Driving Team is all about service, safety and helping people feel cared for throughout the event. You'll be the friendly face transporting shopping and supplies from the festival gates to campsites in golf buggies, helping delegates settle in without the stress of navigating vehicle traffic. During setup and packdown, you'll support Site Ops by driving a small flatbed truck, keeping equipment flowing around site so the whole event can take shape.

You'll work closely with the Info Team during the week, making every interaction warm, helpful and positive, and with Site Ops during the build and packdown to keep everything running smoothly. Your driving will keep people safe, reduces unnecessary vehicle movement and helps create that sense of welcome we want every delegate to feel.

All vehicles must follow our movement rules, including the 10mph speed limit at all times — you'll be one of the guardians of safety on site. While you won't need to lift anything heavy, a willingness to lend a hand and support the team makes all the difference.

What we're looking for:

- Confident, competent drivers with a full, clean UK licence (no points).
- Calm, safety-focused volunteers who can navigate busy environments with care.
- A friendly, people-centred mindset and good communication skills.
- Be over 21 (for vehicle insurance purposes)

Shifts are 8 hours per day, with breaks and support throughout.

What we provide:

- Full training on vehicles, routes and safe movement around site.

How to Apply:

If you are interested in applying for this team please follow the QR code. The application deadline is **Wednesday 1st July 2026**.

To be accepted onto this team every member needs to have a completed reference. Your referee needs to be someone who has had leadership authority over you. This preferably needs to be a youth leader, or senior leader but we will also accept a work manager or a school teacher. Your referee needs to have known you for at least 1 year.

You must need to have a valid Child Workforce DBS check either completed by Limitless or provide one that is on the update service. The deadline to apply for a new DBS is **Friday 17th July 2026**.

You will need to complete the safeguarding training that we will send to you before coming onto site.

You will need to be on site from 10:00 on Tuesday 4 August - 17:00 on Monday 10 August. You can arrive from 9am to set up and **MUST** attend the first all teams meeting at 7pm.
