


HOW TO RECRUIT, RAISE AND RELEASE A VOLUNTEER TEAM - JULIE CAMPBELL AND JAMIE PRICE

HOW TO BUILD A DISCIPLE-MAKING YOUTH MINISTRY - EMMA GAZE

- DAY 1: ELECTIVES SESSION 1 | 14:45-15:45

The great commission has never been to gather crowds, it is to make disciples... so what if attendance and discipleship are not necessarily the same thing? How do we move our ministries from groups that young people attend, to communities in which faith is forged and life-long disciples are made?

HOW TO TALK TO YOUNG PEOPLE ABOUT PUBERTY - FAYE HARRIS

- DAY 1: ELECTIVES SESSION 2 | 16:15-17:15

The teenage years are tumultuous, internally and externally! Brain and body are going through dramatic changes; changes which impact emotions, perspectives and behaviours. So what's our role as youth workers in all this? How do we help our young people understand the impact of puberty on their desires, feelings and relationships? And how do we help them navigate the heightened season of life in a God- glorifying way?

YOUTH MINISTRY INTERVIEW: GENDER-IDENTITY & SEXUALITY: BIBLICAL REFLECTIONS & PASTORAL IMPLICATIONS - ANDREW BUNT

- DAY 2: KEYNOTES | 9:30-10:30

If there's a hot topic in your ministry right now it's sexuality and, in particular, gender-identity. Youth culture has moved so fast in this area that it sometimes feels impossible to keep up. Navigating the tension between adhering to Biblical orthodoxy and creating inclusive spaces for all young people is far from simple. But if there's one thing we must not do it's to dig our head in the sand and fail to engage with it out of fear of getting it wrong. In this session, we interview Andrew about his personal testimony, and consider how we can create truly loving and welcoming environments for LGBT+ young people, whilst remaining steadfast in our commitment to Biblical orthodoxy. This is a subject that we're sure to have strong feelings about, and whilst we will be teaching from a perspective of an historic understanding of Biblical sexuality, this is a safe space where all perspectives are welcome and where we can disagree with kindness and gentleness, preferring one another in love.

YOUTH MINISTRY Q&A - ANDREW BUNT
