Overview:

- Keep an eye on safety during activities, report any concerns, and follow safeguarding procedures.
- Help manage activities, and ensure everything is used responsibly.
- Share feedback with team leader, report issues, and stay updated on the schedule and responsibilities.

How to Apply:

If you are interested in applying for this team please follow the QR code. The application deadline is **Wednesday 1st July 2026**.

To be accepted onto this team every member needs to have a completed reference. Your referee needs to be someone who has had leadership authority over you. This preferably needs to be a youth leader, or senior leader but we will also accept a work manager or a school teacher. Your referee needs to have known you for at least 1 year.

You must need to have a valid Child Workforce DBS check either completed by Limitless or provide one that is on the update service. The deadline to apply for a new DBS is **Friday 17th July 2026**.

You will need to complete the safeguarding training that we will send to you before coming onto site.

You will need to be on site from Wednesday 5th August and can arrive from 9am to set up and **MUST** attend the first all teams meeting at 2pm in the Youth For Christ Cafe.
