Overview:

Responsibilities and requirements:

- The Enabling Teams biggest role is to help enable and facilitate prayer in the youth venue meetings. This will involve helping step in and pray where needed and ensuring that prayer ministry is facilitated in line with Limitless' ministry guidelines.
- Aiding with responses to the gospel giving out response packs to young people and keeping an accurate record of those who have responded to the gospel.
- Being responsive to the appeals given from the front and helping to pray for people where needed
- Where requested, being available for afternoon seminars/workshops to pray with people if desired.

How to Apply:

To be accepted onto this team every member needs to have a completed reference. Your referee needs to be someone who has had leadership authority over you. This preferably needs to be a youth leader, or senior leader but we will also accept a work manager or a school teacher.

Your referee needs to have known you for at least 1 year.

You must need to have a valid Child Workforce DBS check either completed by Limitless or provide one that is on the update service. The deadline to apply for a new DBS is **Friday 17**th **July 2026**.

You will need to complete the safeguarding training that we will send to you before coming onto site.

You will need to be on site from Wednesday 5th August and can arrive from 9am to set up and **MUST** attend the first all teams meeting at 2pm in the Youth For Christ Cafe.
